Re: SATA Enclosure Box (SBB4) on Standard Rackmount DVMS

To all of our customers and partners;

This technical bulletin is to notify you that effective immediately all standard Rackmount units will come with one SATA enclosure box with a single 750GB SATA storage hard drive pre-installed into the first bay. The position of the 80GB SATA OS drive remains unchanged; the OS drive will continue being installed in the front removable hard drive bay on the front right side of the unit.



The bay containing storage hard drive will be locked. The empty bays will remain unlocked and should be locked once new hard drives are installed. (Use the keys shipped in the accessory box).

The 24024R units will accept *two* additional drives; the last bay (extreme right) will have no SATA connection and will not accept an additional drive. The bay with no SATA connection will be labeled accordingly.

All 48024RS and 48032RS units come with a pre-installed SATA expansion card and will accept *three* additional drives.

For more information on how to install additional drive(s) as well as for instructions on how to properly partition the new storage hard drive(s) please refer to the **Technical Bulletin# 080410-HW-04**.
