This is an official hardware change notice. To stay competitive in the constantly changing industry, i³ International Inc. will be changing the motherboard model for the entire line of Rackmount DVRs and NVRs.

Due to our previous positive experience with Intel line of motherboards, we will continue using the Intel brand. Starting September 1st, 2009 all Rackmount DVR models will be switching to **Intel DG43NB** motherboard model from the current *Intel DP35DP*.

Since i³ International Inc. is committed to the UL standard, selected motherboard model carries UL certification, which will ensure that all DVMS manufactured by us are UL-certified.

The new motherboard model, **Intel DG43NB**, meets all the requirements of our Rackmount DVMS line. This motherboard features a total of 6 Serial ATA (SATA) inputs and a total of 12 USB 2.0 ports (6 external, 6 internal). *Intel DG43NB* motherboard supports up to 4GB of RAM and features 3 conventional PCI and 3 PCI Express bus connectors; moreover, this motherboard features excellent on-board video, which will allow us to eventually complete the discontinuation of the VGA adapters on all DVR/NVR models.
