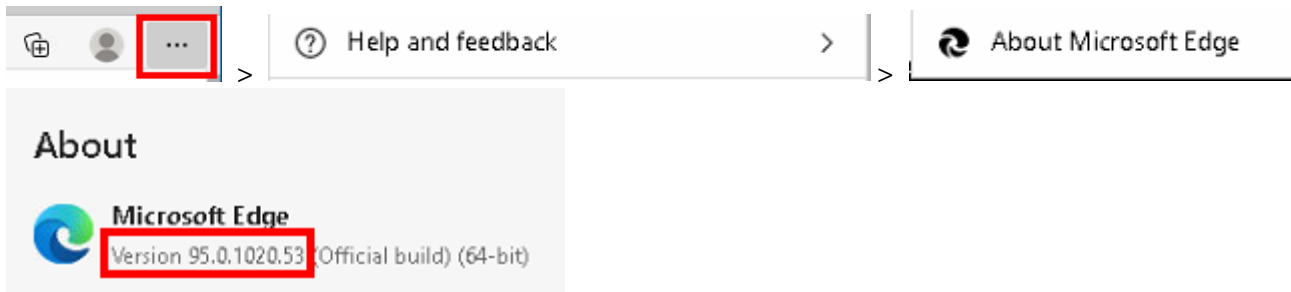


Re: Enabling ActiveX on Microsoft Edge browser.

This bulletin demonstrates the process of enabling ActiveX plugins in Microsoft Edge browser. i3 network cameras rely on ActiveX plug-ins in order to stream live video stream in the web browser. Since Internet Explorer browser is considered End of Life by Microsoft, the following steps can be taken to stream live video from i3 cameras in Microsoft Edge browser.

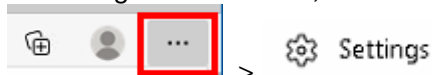
The instructions below are for Microsoft Edge v95 and newer.

To check Microsoft Edge version, click on the ellipsis button > Help and Feedback > About Microsoft Edge

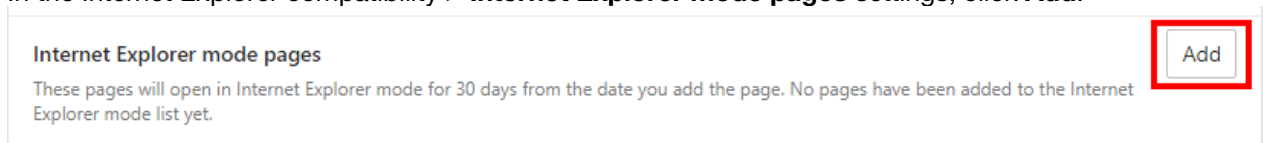
**Enabling ActiveX in Microsoft Edge.**

Note: The steps below may have to be repeated depending on the camera model, as different camera series do not share ActiveX plug-in.

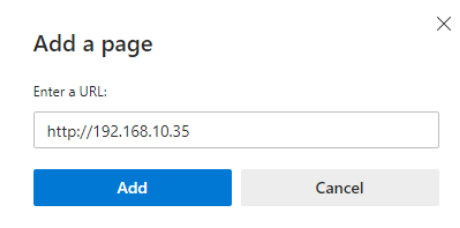
1. In the Edge Web Browser, click on the ellipsis button in the top right-hand corner and click **Settings**.



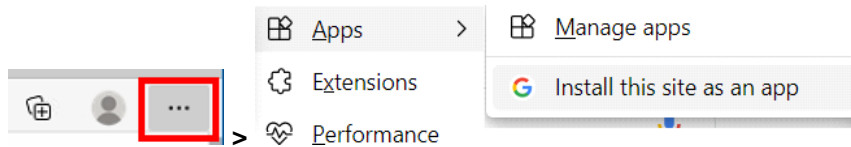
2. In Settings, click **Default browser**
3. In the Internet Explorer compatibility > **Internet Explorer mode pages** settings, click **Add**.



4. Enter the camera's IP address and click **Add**.



5. In the Edge browser, go to the camera's IP address (E.g. <http://192.168.10.35>).
6. Click on the ellipsis button in the top right-hand corner and select **Apps** > **Install this site as an app**



7. Accept the prompt when asked to download the ActiveX plug-in.
Once downloaded, you should be able to see the camera's live stream.
