Re: Daylight Saving Time

In light of the new Energy Policy Act and with the next daylight saving time change approaching, we see the need to address the issue of Daylight Saving Time once again. We remind our customers that as of 2007 the daylight saving time was extended and it now begins on the second Sunday in March and ends on the first Sunday in November.

While most of North America follows the new daylight saving time dates, there are a few exceptions. In United States, Arizona (with the exception of the Navajo Nation), Hawaii and the territories of Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Guam, and American Samoa *do not* use Daylight Saving Time and remain on standard time the entire year.

In Canada, the following cities/areas do not observe daylight saving time: Fort St. John, Charlie Lake, Taylor and Dawson Creek in British Columbia, Creston in the East Kootenays, and most of Saskatchewan (except Denare Beach and Creighton).

The following are the DST start and end dates for the next five years:

	DST Begins	DST Ends
2007	March 11	November 4
2008	March 9	November 2
2009	March 8	November 1
2010	March 14	November 7
2011	March 13	November 6

Impact of extended Daylight Saving Time on i3DVR software:

Due to the fact that i³DVR software operates on Windows OS and that all video recordings are time-stamped according to the OS time, it is important that the DVR's OS time changes in accordance with the new standard in order to maintain accurate timestamp for all video recordings.

We strongly recommend that all dealers and customers of i³DVR install the Microsoft Daylight Saving Time patch on all DVRs by November 4th, 2007 if they have not already done so.

Please note that the installation of this Microsoft patch will prevent any possible complications with i³DVR software and ensure the correct time stamp on i³DVR video recording. This installation will otherwise have no effect on DVR video recording.
